With the added bonus of that unmistakable lavender scent, 'Plumberry Ruffles' is an easy-care yet beautiful addition to an already popular genus.

- Plum inflorescences with lovely ruffled bracts
- Flowers held neatly above the foliage
- Beautiful grey-green foliage
- Long flowering
- Repeat blooms from late winter through to autumn

USES

- Low ornamental hedging - space approximately 45cm apart
- Striking colour impact
- Medium sized decorative containers
- Fragrance and colour for entertainment areas

CARE

Water requirements are low once established. Provide an occasional long soak during periods of extended heat. Plant in a full sun position in a well drained soil. Light tip pruning after flowering will encourage a dense bushy habit and new growth for the following season.
