

Armeria 'Big Dreams' [Ⓛ]

FULL SUN PART SHADE CONTAINER EDGING ATTRACTIVE FOLIAGE CUT FLOWER DRY TOLERANT

FEATURES:

- Larger flowers than other forms - lasting well as cut flowers in arrangements.
- Forms a tight, tufted mound of attractive foliage.
- Long flowering perennial topped with masses of globe shaped flowers for much of the year.
- Low maintenance and easy to grow.
- Dry tolerant once established.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers, small gardens or spaces.
- Fast results for new gardens.
- Edging, rockeries or mixed borders.
- Mass plant as ground cover.
- Suitable for coastal regions.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in full sun in most soil types given good drainage.

Low watering needs once established.

No pruning required although trimming off spent flowers will encourage further flushes.

An application of a slow release fertiliser in late spring is recommended.



With garden spaces decreasing, and some confined to container gardens alone, armerias are compact enough to squeeze between larger shrubs and perennials and grow well in containers. The leafless long flower stems make very contemporary floral displays and last well as cut flowers. The attractive foliage comprises of broader leaves than normally found in this family providing an interesting, textural presence year round. Ideal companions could include - Nepeta 'Lemon Nip', Rhodanthemum 'African Eyes' and Salvias 'Impact-Purple' and 'Aztec Blue'.
