FEATURES:

- Prolific display of bright pink flowers with dark rose central marking.
- Long-lasting flowering from late winter to autumn.
- Fast growing for speedy impact.
- Attracts butterflies and garden pollinators.
- Responds well to clipping for topiary and informal hedging.

- Suitable for large containers/tubs.
- Spectacular flower colour for mixed borders and along path edges
- Water wise for sunny gardens.
- High impact low hedges and topiary.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. Low water requirements once established requiring only an occasional long soak during periods of extended heat. Prune to shape and feed with a slow release fertiliser in late winter.
