## FEATURES:

- A compact and dry tolerant hybrid with colourful foliage for year round interest.
- Foliage comprises of dark, plum coloured rosettes with lime coloured centres holding its deep colour well, even through winter.
- Waterwise landscape selection.
- Easy and fast to grow in garden or container.

## SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers or general garden use.
- Accent feature in mixed borders and gravel style gardens.
- Adds textural interest as well as colour to small garden spaces such as balconies, decks and paved entertainment areas.
- Small or narrow spaces.

## CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. Aeoniums will tolerate cool, frost-free regions over winter if kept dry. No pruning is generally required. Apply a slow release fertiliser during early spring.

The genus of Aeonium encompasses around 35 species with most being native to the Canary Islands but some are also to be found in Madeira, Morocco and East Africa. They are primarily coveted for the sculptural shapes and colours of their foliage as well as their ease of culture in warm to hot climates.

A. 'Du Rozzen' is very compact with a well branching habit. Aeoniums can make striking displays mixed with other succulents such as those in the Sedum BLOB range and S. Dynamite whilst members of the salvia genus make great floral additions with similar likes in growing conditions. For a stunning container combination try mixing with Sedum GREEN BLOB to accentuate the lime green centres.
