

Abelia x grandiflora 'Kaleidoscope' ^(b)

SUGGESTED USES:

- Fast results for new gardens.
- Responds well to clipping for hedging.
- Lengthy colour for mixed borders.
- Colour year round for containers or gardens.

CULTURAL CARE

- Low water requirements once established.
- Grows in most solid types which are well draining.
- A light prune in early spring will help to maintain a compact habit whilst hedging will require further light trims during the year to maintain shape and size required.
- Feed in spring with slow release fertiliser.

A. 'Kaleidoscope' is an exceptionally tough garden variety, which can tolerate extended periods of drought and grows in a wide range of climatic conditions. It has a naturally compact, dense habit and, unlike others within the genus, doesn't form long branching runaway shoots from the base. An outstanding year round colour choice which makes a complementary partner to other ornamental shrubs such as *Teucrium* 'Silverbox', *Loropetalum* 'Plum Gorgeous' and *Lavender* 'Ghostly Princess'.
