

Allium 'Pink Pepper'



 Height: 30cm

FEATURES:

- A prolific display of large globe-shaped, soft pink flowers from spring to summer.
- Neat, mounding habit of strappy green foliage.
- Easy to grow and ideal for small or narrow spaces.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Ideal for mixed shrub or floral borders.
- Can be grown in containers for paved areas, courtyards, decks etc.
- Eye-catching displays can be achieved by planting in drifts - i.e. groups of 3-5.
- Ideal for small or narrow spaces and low edging.
- Plant in and around edible gardens to attract pollinators.

CULTURAL CARE

Easy to grow in most soil types which are moist but well draining. No pruning is generally required although older foliage can be removed once new growth appears in spring to tidy appearance. Foliage may disappear over winter in colder regions with new, fresh foliage appearing in spring. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for optimum results.

A dwarf variety of ornamental allium which provides a swathe of colour on a short plant, making it ideal for edging and gardens with restrictive space. In smaller sized or container gardens, team up with other compact performers such as Salvia 'Impact-Purple', Phlox 'Mc Daniels Cushion' and compact dianthus varieties such as D. 'Sugar Plum' and D. 'Rebekah'. In larger landscapes beautiful floral blends can be achieved using many salvia varieties, compact lavenders such as found in the RUFFLES range, other taller growing phlox - e.g. P. 'Minnie Pearl' as well as anemone and hellebore plants to carry on colour over cooler months.
