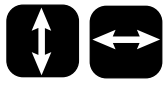


Agapanthus 'Silver Baby'

FEATURES:

- A superb, compact form of agapanthus.
- Produces a lengthy display of silvery-white flowers with subtle ice blue edging from early summer.
- A particularly hardy and easy to grow perennial.
- For all kinds of general, low maintenance garden use.
- Suitable for small gardens or container displays.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Very dry tolerant for water wise landscapes.
- Mass plant for low maintenance areas.
- Mixed borders and edging.
- Dry or gravel style gardens.
- Fast results for new gardens.

CULTURAL CARE

Watering requirements are very low - once established, quite drought tolerant. Grows well in most soil types. Prefers a full sun location although it will tolerate some shade but at the expense of prolific flowering. No pruning required. Apply slow release fertiliser in spring for best results.



Agapanthus are hardy predominately evergreen perennials originating from South Africa and as such are well suited to similar conditions found around Australia. Some ideal garden companions favouring similar conditions would include many forms of Salvia such as Heatwave Salvia range or the lower growing 'S. Impact-Purple'. Daylilies such as H. 'Cranberry Baby' and H. 'Stella Bella' add to a very lengthy floral display whilst a textural ground cover to complement could be achieved with one of the Sedum BLOB range.
