



## Arctotis 'Silverdust Sunshine'

### FEATURES:

- Ornamental foliage of mint green reaches upwards to reveal silvery white undersides.
- A lengthy flowering display begins from late winter continuing through to early summer.
- Flowers of lemon yellow add cheerful, warm colour to the cooler months.
- Tolerant of dry conditions once established.

### SUGGESTED USES:

- Mass plant low maintenance areas.
- Fast results for new gardens.
- Spills over retaining walls or cascades down embankments.
- Large containers.
- Suitable for coastal regions.

### CULTURAL CARE

Low maintenance and easy to grow.  
 Dry tolerant once established requiring only occasional long soak during extended periods of heat.  
 Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. No pruning is required.  
 Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser.

For quick coverage with stunning colour - take a look at the fast growing, ground covering Arctotis SILVERDUST varieties. Ornamental, silvery green foliage offers an attractive year round highlight between darker coloured shrubs and perennials whilst providing a beautifully contrasting foil for its display of large, vibrantly coloured flowers appearing throughout the cooler months. Dry tolerant plants for low maintenance areas and water wise gardening. Arctotis are native to dry, southern regions of Africa making them climatically suited to Australian which is why they are often favoured for public gardens where they can perform happily without much attention in often difficult sites including down slopes.
