

## *Allium lusitanicum* 'Summer Beauty'

### FEATURES:

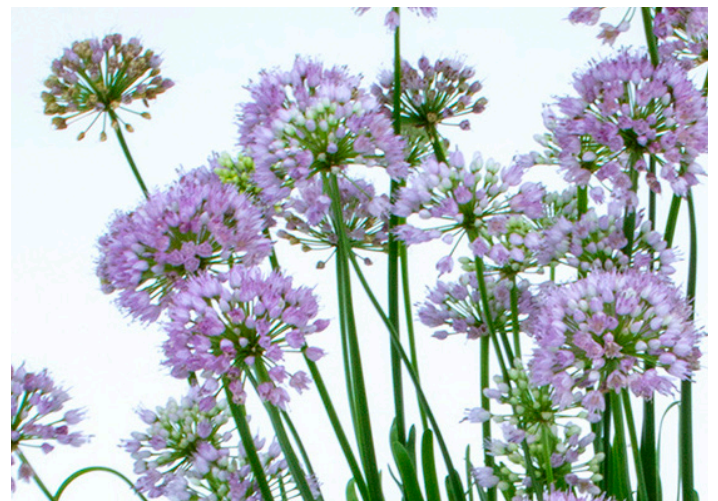
- A prolific display of large globe-shaped, soft pink flowers from spring to summer.
- Neat, mounding habit of strappy green foliage.
- Easy to grow and ideal for small or narrow spaces.
- Pollinator friendly.

### SUGGESTED USES:

- Ideal for mixed shrub or floral borders.
- Can be grown in containers for paved areas, courtyards, decks etc.
- Eye-catching displays can be achieved by planting in drifts - i.e. groups of 3-5.
- Ideal for small or narrow spaces and low edging.
- Plant in and around edible gardens to attract pollinators.

### CULTURAL CARE

Easy to grow in most soil types which are moist but well draining. No pruning is generally required although older foliage can be removed once new growth appears in spring to tidy appearance. Foliage may disappear over winter in colder regions with new, fresh foliage appearing in spring. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for optimum results.



A no-nonsense, easy to grow allium which provides a swathe of colour and texture when planted en-mass in garden spaces. Great garden companions could include many types of Salvia such as S. 'Impact-Purple' and the deep pink flowers of S. 'Heatwave Sparkle'. Further naturalistic blends could include ground covering Phlox 'Mc Daniels Cushion' and the taller P. 'Minnie Pearl' whilst fragrant Dianthus varieties such as D. 'Memories' and D. 'Candy Floss Mauve' can add yet another sensory facet to your display with their beautifully fragrant blooms.
