FEATURES:

- An excellent form from an ornamental family commonly known as 'bellflowers'.
- A lengthy display of blue flowers with a white central eye appear from spring through to winter.

 The tiny heart shaped leaves form an attractive dense mat which is everareen.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Mass plant as ground cover for low light areas.
- Will cascade over rockeries, embankments and retaining walls.
- Edging for garden beds, paths or paved areas.
- •Small gardens, containers and general garden use.

CULTURAL CARE

Suited to most soil types which are moist but well draining. Trim back after main flowering to encourage neat, dense habit.

Apply a slow release fertiliser during early spring for best results.
