FEATURES:

- A prolific display of large, bell-shaped flowers (up to 5cm long) of mauve colour from late summer into autumn.
- Upright habit - slowly spreading to form a clump.
- Easy to grow with reliable garden performance.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Lightly shaded gardens.
- Mass plant as ornamental ground cover.
- Excellent in containers.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are moist but well draining. Can be grown predominantly in full sun when given protection from hot afternoon sun. Remove older foliage once flowering finishes and new growth appears in spring to tidy appearance.

Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring. Mulch well to help retain moisture during dry periods.

This variety of Campanula displays rather large flowers in the typical bell shape that gives rise to the common name of 'bellflower'. *Campana* being Latin for 'bells'. Originating from temperate and subtropical regions of the Northern Hemisphere with a large number hailing from areas of the Mediterranean. C. 'Barbara Valentine' is a beautiful and elegant addition to low light areas where it can be blended with other plant partners such as Pulmonaria 'Electric Blue', the mat forming and white flowering Campanula 'EH Frost', Anemone 'Queen Charlotte' for some complementary pink and lastly, the silvery foliage of Lamium 'Snow 'n' Frost' will provide an ornamental 'skirt' year round.
