Coreopsis hybrid 'Little Penny'

















- Mass display of copper coloured flowers from spring through to early winter.
- A much neater, more compact habit that other varieties currently available.
- Fast growing ideal for adding colourful bulk to border displays.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Gardens or containers as well as small spaces.
- Exceptional performance for mixed border displays where drifts of two to three plants can form a bright accent.
- Fast results for new gardens.
- •Strong colour for many months spring to autumn.

CULTURAL CARE

Easy to grow in most soil types which are moist but well draining. Over winter months, in cooler climates it may become semi herbaceous with new, fresh foliage appearing in spring. Prune by half after main flowering flushes to encourage further displays.

Coreopsis are workhorses in the sunny garden border with long, repeating flower displays through the warmer months. Dehead spent flowers to help keep foliage dense and fresh looking as well as encouraging new flushes.

Ideal companions for using in a low border could include Salvia 'Impact Purple', dwarf daylily Hemerocallis 'Stella Bella' and sedums such as S. 'Silver Blob' or S. 'Green Blob'. Create a foil behind with taller growing plants such as FIESTA agastaches, euphorbias, taller salivas or ornamental grasses.
