FEATURES:

- A clump forming, very compact shrub ideal for small spaces or containers.
- Long displays of dainty white flowers over the warmer months with self cleaning of spent blooms.
- Fast growing with aromatic foliage.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers, small spaces or general garden use.
- Attracting pollinators to gardens.
- Edging or for front of mixed borders.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are moist but well draining. May become herbaceous during winter in very cold climates - remove any old foliage during late winter and fresh new foliage should then be encouraged with an application of slow release fertiliser at this time for optimum results. Frost tolerant once established. Mulch well to help retain moisture during times of extended heat.

Calamintha nepeta is a perennial belonging to the mint family and does release an aromatic fragrance when foliage is crushed. The airy clouds of tiny blooms makes this variety a choice selection for mixed container displays where you can blend with the highly perfumed Dianthus 'Sugar Plum' and a trailer such as Phox 'Scarlet Flame' for a very generous flower display. In the garden, for a mixed display of texture and colour, plant alongside Cosmos 'Chocoholic' and Helianthemum 'Fire Dragon Sunrose' whilst softening front with planting of a ground cover such as Convolvulus 'New Blue Moon' and Cerastium 'Snow In Summer'.
