

Convolvulus sabitius 'New Blue Moon' Ⓢ



Spreading Ground Cover



FEATURES:

- Improved form of popular ground cover with far denser, neater habit.
- Deep blue, funnel-like flowers through the warmer months.
- Low maintenance, dry tolerant and easy to grow.
- Will trail over rocks and walls.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers and general garden use.
- Low maintenance areas.
- Embankments, rockeries and retaining walls.
- Spaces between larger perennials and shrubs.
- Pool side planting and coastal zones.
- Dense habit helps to suppress weeds.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soils that are well draining. Watering requirements are low once established requiring only occasional deep watering over extended periods of heat. No pruning required. An addition of a slow release fertiliser in spring recommended to encourage profuse flowering.

A long standing landscaping favourite as a reliable ground cover for sunny sites due to its ease of growth, care and ornamental qualities. C. 'New Blue Moon' has been bred as a denser, tighter growing form of its famous predecessor C. 'Blue Moon'. Exhibiting the same prolific display of deep blue flowers it will maintain a naturally neater and thicker habit making it especially suited to containers as well as its traditional use as a weed suppressing ground cover. Individual plants spot planted around the front of borders will also add a very long flowering period to mixed borders. Ideal for low fuss gardening!
