

Dianthus barbatus 'Heart Attack'

FEATURES:

- Profuse and repeating displays of deep red, fragrant flowers from late spring into summer.
- Forms a neat, cushion-like mound of foliage with a purplish tint.

- Cottage, wild flower or rockery style gardens.
- Attracts pollinators.
- Flowers last well cut for floral arrangements.

CULTURAL CARE

Low maintenance and easy to grow in most soil types which are free draining. Dry and frost tolerant once established. Removing spent flower stems will help prolong flower displays whilst a prune back of older foliage during late winter will tidy and encourage a dense habit. Apply slow release fertiliser in spring and protect from snails for optimum results.

An ideal variety for attracting butterflies to your garden as well as lasting well indoors as cut flower posy. Its compact size and fragrant blooms make it a choice selection as a container planting for entertainment areas or entrance ways.
