'CANDY FLOSS'

Awarded the prestigious Award of Garden Merit (AGM) by the UK's Royal Horticultural Society, 'Candy Floss' is a cut above the pack with sugar-pink ruffled flowers with flashes of darker pink at the base of the heavily perfumed petals. But don't be deceived by the delicate flowers, this is a sun hardy and tough plant suited to the hot Australian summer sun.

- Wonderfully fragrant
- Cut flowers last well for floral arrangements
- Evergreen and hardy without any special needs
- Will repeat bloom if spent flowers are removed
- Heavy flowering in spring over an extensive period

USES

- Container displays for lengthy colour
- Small gardens, patios and courtyards
- Fragrance for entertainment areas and entrances
- Ideal for low edging around garden beds or paving
- Great for rockeries and filling small gaps in perennial borders

CARE

Low water requirements. Once established, quite dry tolerant only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat. Low maintenance and easy to grow. Apply a slow release fertiliser during early spring. No pruning generally required although removing spent flower stems will encourage further flushes.
