CULTURAL CARE

Dry tolerant once established, requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat. Plant in most soil types that are well draining.

Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser according to manufacturer's directions. If pruning, take care to avoid contact with sap.

CAUTION: Harmful if eaten/skin & eye irritant.
