## FEATURES:

## CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soils which are well draining. Once established water requirements are low but do not allow to dry out over extended periods of heat. Pruning generally not required other than to tidy. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for best results.

Members of the genus *Escallonia* originate from regions of South America and are widely cultivated around the world due to their toughness and the ease of which they can be grown. A relatively fast grower, it is ideal for establishing a hedge or topiary specimen in a short period of time with a fresh appearance thanks to its emerald green, glossy foliage. Trimming for hedging will be at the expense of some flowering, however, so if you prefer - leave to grow to its natural form for a longer flowering period in mixed borders or shrubberies. They stand up well to coastal conditions and windy areas and grow well in most soil types. For ornamental shrub borders try mixing with *Daphne* 'Eternal Fragrance', *Loropetalum* 'Plum Gorgeous' and *Choysia* 'White Dazzler' for a rich tapestry of foliage and flower colour with splashes of perfumed flowers.
