## CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soils which are well draining. Once established water requirements are low but do not allow to dry out over extended periods of heat. Pruning generally not required other than to tidy. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for best results.

Members of the genus *Escallonia* originate from regions of South America and are widely cultivated around the world due to their toughness and the ease of which they can be grown. A relatively fast grower, it is ideal for establishing a hedge or topiary specimen in a short period of time. Trimming for hedging can be at the expense of some flowering but if left to grow to its natural form you can enjoy a longer flowering period. *Escallonias* stand up well to coastal conditions and windy areas and grow well in most soil types.
