

Enliven dark spots in the garden with the stunning crisp white foliage highlights of this new and unique Rengarenga Lily. Arthropodiums are New Zealand native lilies that are well known to gardeners and garden designers through the success of cultivars such as 'Matapouri Bay' and 'Te Puna'. 'Moonbeam' is a fine addition to the gardener's palette performing equally as well as its cousins, but with an impactful shot of white that really catches the eye.

CARE

Water requirements are medium once established. If growing in containers, care should be taken not to allow to dry out completely. Plant in a welldraining potting media in pots or in an enriched soil in the garden. For best results, feed in late autumn and spring with a slow release fertiliser. Protect from hot summer sun. Protect from heavy frosts and snails. CONTAINERS
