Cosmos 'Cherry Chocolate' is a stunning new cultivar of the beloved Chocolate Cosmos. This lovely form produces purple buds that boasts large fuchsia-pink blooms with bright golden pollen, along with an enticing rich chocolate fragrance. 'Cherry Chocolate' flowers are the largest of any Cosmos atrosanguineus, making it an eye catching form and a delight in the garden. With a potential of a five month long flowering period, 'Cherry Chocolate' is an excellent repeat bloomer. With low maintenance requirements due to the compact habit, minimal pruning and a fast turnaround this is one perennial that is sure to impress.

CARE

Moderate water requirements, keep soil moist but leave surface to dry out before watering again. Tubers can rot if waterlogged. Plant in well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Fertilise moderately. Bury the rooted plug in the centre of the pot, do not plant too high. Keep foliage dry, water at the base of the plant.
