

Helleborus hybrid 'Molly's White'

This plant is a registrable plant variety under section 43(6) of the Plant Breeders Rights Act 1994

FEATURES:

- Beautiful white flowers with blush pink tones from winter to spring.
- Long flowering period.
- Tolerant of dry and low light conditions.
- Vigorous evergreen perennial with a tidy growth habit.
- Easy to grow and exceptionally hardy.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Elegance and style for shady nooks.
- Mass plant in groups of five or more for high impact display in winter.
- Use in containers or garden beds.
- Grown in containers, they can be brought indoors for short periods during display times.
- Suitable for planting beneath tree canopies.

CULTURAL CARE

- Low water requirements once established.
- Prefers a rich but well draining soil.
- No pruning required although removing spent flower stems encourages further displays.
- If grown in containers or full sun - take care to not allow to dry out completely.
- Feed in late autumn and again in spring with slow release fertiliser for optimum results.

CAUTION: Harmful if eaten / skin irritant.
