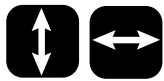


Iberis sempervirens 'Winter Glow'

ATTRACTIVE FOLIAGE

FEATURES:

- A mass display of lacy, snow white flower heads from late winter through spring.
- Spreading ground cover of attractive evergreen foliage.
- Spot flowering can also occur at other times of the year.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Mass plant large drifts for decorative ground cover .
- Container or hanging basket displays.
- Soft edging for paths or paved areas.
- Will cascade over retaining walls, rockeries and embankments.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types that are moist but well draining. Tolerates dry conditions well once established but should not be allowed to dry out completely during extended periods of heat. No pruning generally required. Feed after main flowering flush with a slow release fertiliser for best results.



A small evergreen shrub which spreads slowly to form a neat, low cushion. Commonly known as 'Candytuft', it is native to southern regions of Europe. It will tolerate some light shade but flowering will be less. Best suited as edging towards front of borders or as a filler between larger perennials and shrubs. Terrific effects can be achieved in a mixed container or hanging basket where choosing a companion with larger leaves and/or flowers such as: Stokesia 'Blue Parasols', or even mingling with other trailers such as Convolvulus 'New Blue Moon' and Helianthemum 'Fire Dragon Sunrose'.
