## FEATURES:


- Vibrant coloured flowers stud foliage in profusion from spring into summer.
- Succulent foliage forms a low growing mound.
- Hardy, easy to grow and very dry tolerant once established.

## SUGGESTED USES:

- Mass plant difficult sites as a fast growing, low maintenance ground cover.
- Contemporary gardens, mixed perennial borders or cascading over walls and embankments.
- Containers or general garden use.

## CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are well draining and in a sunny location. Do not over water. No pruning generally required. An application of slow release fertiliser during spring would be beneficial to overall performance.



The genus *Lampranthus* contains around 155 species - mostly native to regions of southern Africa. The genus name translates from the Greek words *lampros* - bright and *anthos* - flower. This species forms a low growing mat of succulent foliage and makes an easy-care plant for mixed borders. For a sunny, ornamental 'curtain' of colour to trail over walls and embankments - try mixing with companions such as Sedums GREY BLOB and SILVER BLOB along with ground covering *Convolvulus* 'Arctic Moon'.
