- Forms neat, rounded mounds of lime green, evergreen foliage.
- Hardy and easy to grow.
- Makes an ideal ground cover as well as a tough edging for low maintenance areas.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Native style gardens.
- Mass plant for low maintenance ground cover.
- •Suited to both formal and informal landscapes.
- Stabiliser for edgings, embankments and erosion control.
- Coastal regions or poolside landscaping.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. Dry tolerant although an occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat is recommended. No pruning is generally necessary although, if required, to rejuvenate foliage with fresh new growth - cut back to approx. 10cm from base in early spring or autumn. Feed in spring with a native formulated fertiliser.
