

Lavandula 'Fairy Wings Spellbound'

FEATURES:

- Dry tolerant with outstanding performance under Australian conditions.
- Flowers are produced for a lengthy period beginning from late winter into summer.
- Striking flower heads capped with deep lavender coloured 'ribbons' are highly ornamental in garden or tub displays.
- Low maintenance, fast and easy to grow.

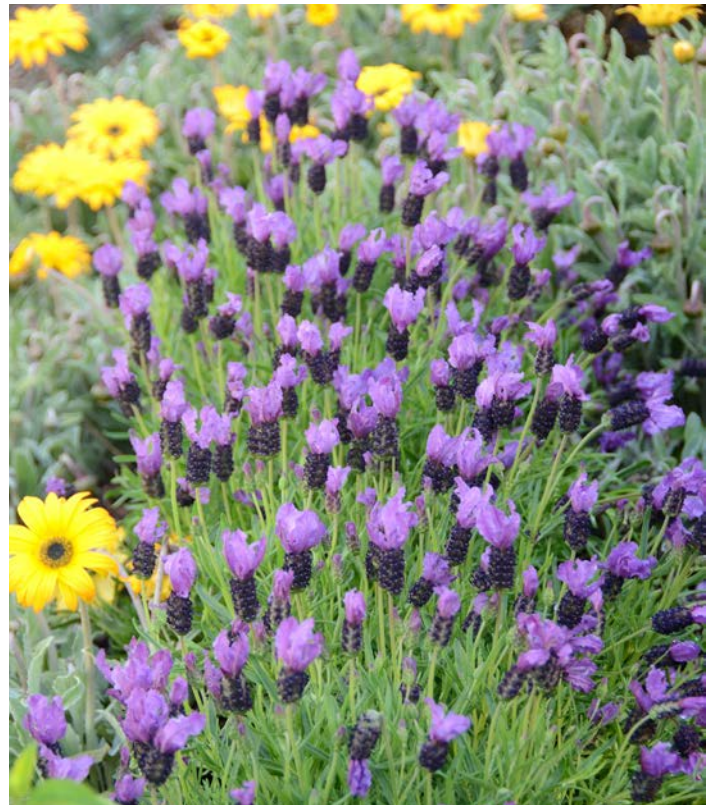
SUGGESTED USES:

- Ideal for mixed shrub or floral borders.
- Can be grown in large containers for paved areas, courtyards, decks etc.
- Eye-catching displays can be achieved by planting in drifts - i.e. groups of 3-5
- Create informal, low hedging.
- Ideal for sensory and children's gardens.
- Plant in and around edible gardens to attract pollinators.

CULTURAL CARE

Best results achieved when situated in full sun location in most soil types which are well draining. A light prune after main flowering flush will encourage a dense, compact habit and additional flowering.

Apply slow release fertiliser during late summer to early autumn for optimum results.
