### **CULTURAL CARE**

Grows well in most soils that are well draining. Watering requirements are low once established requiring only occasional deep watering over extended periods of heat. Prune back to two thirds of original size in late summer to maintain health and vigour. Apply a light sprinkling of Dolomite lime and slow release fertiliser after pruning for optimum results.

L. 'Ghostly Princess' was bred in Australia and selected for its highly ornamental foliage and lengthy flowering season. Lavenders have been choice garden selections around the world for centuries due to their medicinal attributes along with their ease of culture and beautiful floral displays. Ideal for growing around vegetables or fruit trees where they encourage beneficial pollinators. Easy to trim for topairy specimens or for hedging. Create a frothy floral border by growing with Coreopsis 'Pink Lady', Lampranthus 'Pink Explosion', Nemesia 'Confetti White' and Phlox 'Minnie Pearl'.
