CARE

Low water requirements. Dry tolerant once established. Plant in a sunny location in well draining soil. Clip back to two thirds of it's size in late summer to maintain shape and vigour. After pruning an application of slow release fertiliser would be beneficial. FULL SUN/PART SHADE
