

Nepeta x faassenii 'Purrsian Blue'



Height 30cm

FEATURES:

- Excellent selection with a much tidier and low mounding habit.
- Forms a cushion of aromatic grey/green foliage.
- A mass display of lavender blue flower spikes appear in late spring continuing through summer and autumn.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Compact variety suitable for containers and small spaces.
- Ideal for mixed borders and herb gardens.
- Attracts pollinators.
- Fast growing for low maintenance areas.

CULTURAL CARE

Low maintenance and easy to grow. Once established, quite drought tolerant requiring only occasional long soak during extended periods of heat. A decisive prune of up to half its size after the first main flush will encourage a dense habit and further flowering. Can be heavily cut back in winter to encourage dense, fresh growth in spring. Apply a slow release fertiliser in spring to encourage profuse flowering.
