Origanum 'Sunnymeade'

FEATURES:

- Forms a whispy mound of ornamental and aromatic foliage.
- •Small, shrimp-like flower stems of soft pink bracts appear from spring through to autumn.
- Dry tolerant for water wise gardens.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers or general garden use.
- Edging or pollinator plant for herb/vegetable gardens.
- For ornamental use only.

CULTURAL CARE

Most soil types which are well draining. Dry tolerant once established but will benefit from occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat. In colder regions may become herbaceous with fresh new foliage re-appearing in spring. Pruning generally not required although older foliage can be trimmed to tidy if required. Apply slow release fertiliser during spring.
