## FEATURES:

- A striking display of 'forget-me-not' like flowers over spring.
- Flower colour begins as a deep cobalt blue colour maturing to violet shades.
- Attractive foliage forms a lush ground cover when planted in groups.
- Fast and easy to grow - ideal for low light areas and small spaces.

## SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers or general garden use.
- Edging or for front of mixed borders.
- Small or narrow spaces.

## CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are moist but well draining. No pruning is generally required. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring and mulch well to help retain moisture during dry periods. Protect from strong afternoon sun. Frost tolerant.

Omphalodes works very well as a mass planting for a lush carpet of foliage in low light areas where it will happily mingle with other perennials such as Geranium 'Karmina' and G. 'Biokovo'. Interplant with ornamental hellebores such as H. 'Pennys Pink' and H. 'Tutu' to extend interest in winter months. The addition of foliage plants such as Brunnera 'Sea Heart' and Aujga 'Chocolate Chip' will complement your landscape grouping for much of the year round.
