FEATURES:

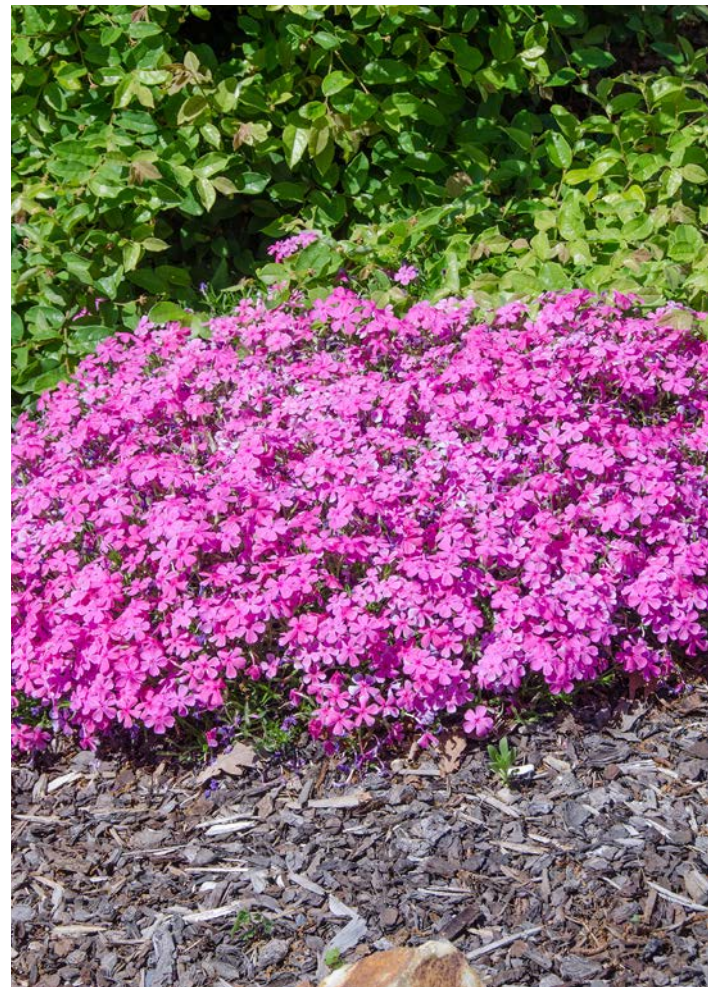
- Bright pink flowers can completely cover foliage when at peak display.
- Colourful ground cover planted en masse.
- Long flowering from early spring to autumn.
- Ideal for containers or general garden use.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Rockeries or embankments.
- Containers and hanging baskets.
- Small gardens, spaces or narrow areas.
- Mixed borders and general garden use.

CULTURAL CARE

Prefers an open, well draining soil in a sunny location although afternoon shade will be tolerated. Medium watering requirements withstanding some dryness but should be watered regularly during extended periods of heat. Apply a slow release fertiliser in late summer. Frost hardy.



One of the mat forming phlox varieties more commonly known as 'moss or alpine phlox'. Native to regions of eastern North America, they are very showy when in flower and attract pollinators such as butterflies. Sun-loving and a vigorous grower when in a sunny, well drained location and can spread to great widths if given the space. Ideal planting companions could include compact lavenders - such as those in the RUFFLES range, Sedum 'Silver Blob' and Sedum 'Green Blob' as well as compact and fragrant dianthus varieties from the Scent First range.
