## FEATURES:

- Long flowering perennial topped with masses of clustered, bright amethyst flowers from early spring to autumn.
- Colourful ground cover planted en masse.

## CULTURAL CARE

Prefers an open, well draining soil in a full sun location although afternoon shade will be tolerated. Removing spent flowers will encourage further flushes. Medium watering requirements withstanding some dryness but should be watered regularly during extended periods of heat. Apply a slow release fertiliser in autumn. Pruning generally not required.

One of the mat forming phlox varieties more commonly known as 'moss or alpine phlox'. Native to regions of eastern North America, they are very showy when in flower and attract pollinators such as butterflies. Sun-loving and a vigorous grower when in a sunny, well drained location and can spread to great widths if given the space. Ideal planting companions could include compact lavenders - such as those in the RUFFLES range, Sedum 'Silver Blob' and Sedum 'Green Blob' as well as compact and fragrant dianthus varieties from the Scent First range.
