Pratia pedunculata alba COUNTRY WHITE

Spreading ground cover



FEATURES:

- Forms a dense carpet of lush green foliage that will also creep between rocks and crevices.
- Fast and easy to grow in low light areas.
- Studded with dainty, intensely blue flowers from late spring through to autumn.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Great cover for difficult sites and will trail over embankments and over walls.
- Mass plant areas for weed suppression.
- Can be grown in containers or baskets where it can fill spaces in a mixed display.

CULTURAL CARE

Performs best in moist, well draining soils. No pruning is required. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for best results. Protect from drying out during extend periods of heat or times of low rain fall.

Pratia is a genus native to Asia, Australia and New Zealand and is particularly useful as either a mat forming ground cover or as a filler between larger plants and shrubs, rocks, pavers etc. For either garden or large container displays in low light areas, team up with Anemone 'Pamina' and A. 'Marchenfee' whilst larger shrubs could include Daphne 'Spring Pink' and Plectranthus 'Mona Lavender'.
