



Pelargonium FAIRY PINK



Height: 25cm

FEATURES:

- A lengthy display of dainty, magenta flowers from spring through to winter.
- Attractive, deeply cut, emerald green foliage year round.
- Easy to grow and hardy for most situations.
- Ideal for small or narrow spaces.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers or general garden use.
- Water wise garden designs.
- Edging or for front of mixed borders.
- Rockeries and wildflower style gardens.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are moist but well draining. Water requirements low once established. Mulching around plant will help retain moisture during extended dry periods. No pruning is generally required although removing spent flowers encourages further flushes. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring. Frost tolerant.

Fast growing, long flowering and pretty hardy! Enjoys a sunny location in well draining soil where it will give a colour packed show for much of the year! Though not a true ground cover, they can be mass planted in areas where once they entwine, will give a satisfactory and ornamental blanket of foliage and flower - particularly useful on steep slopes or rockeries. Will gracefully spill over container edges and can be integrated in to most mixed border displays where it should be used in multiples for best effect. Combine with Verbena 'Homestead Purple', Verbena 'Fragrant Lilac' and Agastache 'Raspberry Fiesta' for an airy, pink and purple layered effect. Strongly recommended for low water use landscapes as once established, little will bother it.
