

Persicaria microcephala 'Red Dragon'

FEATURES:

- Dramatic year round colour from foliage of deep plum with silvery V shaped markings.
- Tough and easy to grow with a clumping habit suitable for containers and as a colourful infill for mixed borders.
- Tolerant of clay soils and wet areas.
- Sprays of contrasting white flowers appear over spring.

SUGGESTED USES:

- To make most of colourful foliage position beside contrasting silver or lime green foliaged plants.
- Can be grown in containers for paved areas, courtyards, decks etc.
- Eye-catching displays can be achieved by planting in drifts - i.e. groups of 3-5.
- Ideal for small or narrow spaces and low edging.
- Ideal for creating 'lush' foliage schemes when paired with other ornamental companions such as *Arthropodium* 'Matapouri Bay', *Heuchera* 'Caramel Curl' and *Liriope* 'Emerald Cascade'.

CULTURAL CARE

Easy to grow in most soil types situated in sun to partial shade. Prune hard in late autumn to enjoy fresh foliage colour over the winter months. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for optimum results.
