

Rhodanthemum AFRICAN EYES Amber Eye

FEATURES:

- Fine, lacy foliage of silvery grey provides year round colour and interest.
- White daisy-like flowers with deep amber centres are produced from mid winter through to mid summer.
- Ideal for mixed plantings in gardens or containers.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Spill over for retaining walls and/or rockeries.
- General garden use or containers.
- Small gardens and mixed flower borders.
- Pollinator attracting plant.
- Mass plant as ornamental ground cover.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types but thrives in fertile, well draining soils. Medium tolerance to dry conditions once established.

Trim lightly to maintain shape and encourage a dense, bushy habit in early spring and again after heavy flowering.

An application of slow release fertiliser in early spring is recommended for best results.
