

Rosa polyantha 'The Fairy'

FEATURES:

- Beautiful, small shrub rose with graceful arching habit over low growing mound.
- Repeat displays of dainty, soft pink flower clusters from late spring continuing through the warmer months.
- Hardy and easy to grow - low maintenance.
- Feature plant for gardens or containers.
- Very disease resistant variety.
- Recipient of **Award of Garden Merit** of the Royal Horticultural Society.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Water wise landscapes and general garden use.
- Suitable for large containers.
- Suitable for urban environments.
- Can be mass planted for low maintenance areas.
- Create a low, informal flowering hedge.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. Best performance in full sun but will tolerate part shade. Prune back to a neat dome shape in autumn after main flowering has ended. Cutting spent flower stems will encourage further flushes. In colder regions may be semi evergreen with new fresh foliage appearing in spring. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for optimum performance.
