

Rhodanthe anthemoides 'Paper Girl'

This plant is a registrable plant variety under section 43(6) of the Plant Breeders Rights Act 1994.

FEATURES:

- Deep pink buds opening to white, papery flowers cloak foliage in spring - commonly known as 'everlastings'.
- Australian native bred for compact habit.
- Soft, grey-green foliage has an aromatic 'chamomile-like' fragrance.
- Foliage forms a neat, rounded mound with a trailing habit.
- Easy to grow for gardens, containers or hanging baskets.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Will trail over rocks, walls and embankments.
- When in flower lasts up to 6 weeks as a living, indoor decoration.
- Flowers can be dried for crafts.
- Suitable for gardens in coastal regions.

CULTURAL CARE

Plant in a moist but well draining soil. Tolerates full sun but is best suited in a location with morning sun and afternoon shade. Do not allow to dry out during extended periods of heat. Prune back by approximately one third of overall size in autumn and give an application of slow release fertiliser at this time.

Bring a bit of the unique Australian bush into your garden with this new take on the classic Australian native alpine daisy. The rounded and compact form of this plant is completely covered with a dazzling show of flowering power from the end of winter and deep into spring. The buds emerge from the cold with a pink tinge that opens to reveal large white paper-daisy flowers that make a great display in the garden or cut for a vase posy.
