- Flushes of red snapdrgon-like flowers cover the low mounding foliage from summer through to autumn.
- Fabulous for small spaces or edging and will spill over walls and rockeries.
- •Salt, wind and dry tolerant once established.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Mixed borders and containers.
- Makes an attractive around cover for small areas.
- Pollinator friendly plant.



Grows well in most soil types which are well draining. Dry tolerant once established requiring only occasional deep watering during periods of extended heat. Avoid waterlogged conditions.

An addition of a slow release fertiliser in spring recommended.

No pruning generally required.

Mulching helps to retain moisture during warmer months.
