BIRD ATTRACTING

FEATURES:

- Fast growing and hardy.
- Long flowering - late spring to autumn.
- Stunning deep blue flower spikes set against grey green foliage.
- Makes an eye catching addition to mixed perennial or shrub borders.
- Attracts birds and can be cut for fresh floral arrangements.

- Water wise gardens.

- Ideal for adding bulk to garden landscapes.

CULTURAL CARE

Low maintenance and easy to grow. Grows well in most free draining soils and is very dry tolerant once established requiring only occasional deep watering during extended periods of heat. Apply a slow release fertiliser in spring. Prune by half after main flowering period to tidy and again in early spring to remove old stems revealing new growth.

Known for their resilience to dry climates and ease of culture, Salvias are a great way to fill the garden with colour almost year round. Including over 900 species they form the largest genus in the mint family (Lamiaceae) and certainly almost all will release an aromatic fragrance when the foliage is brushed against or crushed. Team up with S. 'Limelight', S. 'Velour White' and S. 'Wendys Wish' for a colourful back drop to lower growing foliage plants such as Euphorbia 'Silver Swan', Abelia 'Kaleidoscope' and Convolvulus 'Silvery Moon' for added sparkle to a border.
