- Forms a carpet of glossy, dark green foliage.
- Flowers in the shade!
- Displays of purple flowers with white highlights appear from late summer through
- Easy to grow and low maintenance for shady areas.



- Containers or general garden use.
- Low light situations.
- Edging or for front of mixed borders.
- Small or narrow spaces.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soil types which are moist but well draining. No pruning is generally required. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring. Mulch well to protect crown in areas where frosts may occcur.

Tricyrtis forms a genus of around 20 species originating in Asian regions from the Eastern Himalayas through to the Philippines. More commonly known as 'toad lily', they are highly

regarded garden plants for their ability to flower in shade and the attractive orchid-like flowers they produce. Try and place plantings close to where they can be observed by visitors.

They are ideal for container culture as well as small gardens but utilised for garden beds they mix well with other shade lovers such as Omphalodes 'Cherry Ingram', Brunnera 'Silver Heart', as well as anemone and lamium varieties for beautiful woodland or naturalised appeal in difficult sites.
